Féile General Rules and Conditions:

Feis Procedure

- 1 Any objections (other than those relating to adjudicators decisions) must be lodged **in writing** to the Féile Committee with a fee of €20.00 and only accepted from registered teachers. If the Féile committee cannot resolve the issue satisfactorily, the objection will be forward to Comhairle Na Mumhan.
- 2 Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition. (Jan '05)

Feis Administration

- 3 Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiun.
- 4 Age is reckoned from January 1st. 5. The Adjudicator's decision is final
- 6 Post competitions must have both a light and heavy result where both jig types have been performed
- 7 The Feis Committee will not accept responsibility for personal injury or personal articles lost/damaged
- 8 The Feis Committee will as far as practicable provide surfaces suitable for Irish Dancing. However, the Féile Committee cannot accept liability whatsoever, for any injuries sustain while on Stage. The lodgement of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by the dance, parent or guardian

Competitors Attire and Conduct

- 9 Make-up is not permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including Under 12 age group
- 10 In Bun Grad or Tus Grad are permitted to wear either class costumes or day wear:- Girls class costumes, day dress or Skirt & Blouse / Boys Class Costume or Pants & Shirt (Munster specific rule)
- 11 The use of artificial carriage aids is strictly forbidden except in cases of a medical condition where a doctors certificate may be requested. Any competitor found to be using artificial carriage aids and subsequently refuses to remove same, will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition. Medically prescribed apparatus (proof of which may be required) will be exempt from this ruling.
- 12 Under no circumstances should dancers walk around any dancing venue in their underwear. Neither should dancers (regardless of age) change into or out of costume in the main dancing hall if at all possible. At all times, dancers should be properly attired.
- 13 No block, en pointe work, stationary or moving is allowed to be performed for all ages up to and including Under 12 age group, with the exception of the 11-12 age group who may perform this as & from 1st Sept.
- 14 Should a dancer fall on stage, the adjudicator **MUST** ring the bell to stop the performance of the dancer(s). The dancer(s) so affected will be permitted to re dance at the discretion of the adjudication panel, or by a majority of adjudicators, where there is a judging panel. Should, in the opinion of the stage steward, having obtained medical advice if necessary, a dancer be unfit to re dance and if such dancer insists on his/her right to do so then the dancer concerned may be permitted to re-dance on completion of a declaration form exonerating the committee of liability for any consequences.
- 15 Should a dancer lose a heel or a complete shoe he/she may stand back allowing the other dancer, where applicable, to continue dancing uninhibited. In such a case, the dancer concerned will be permitted to re-dance as soon as it is deemed practicable by the stage steward.

Grade Rules:

- (a) In Reel competitions under 5 years, dancers must perform Easy Reel material only...(Munster specific rule).
- (b) A competition in which there are five competitors or less shall not count for grading purposes i.e. the winner of such a competition shall be entitled to dance again in a competition for the same dance in the same age group and grade. (1994). This rule includes the ARD Grade Solo competitions **As of Jan 1st 2009**, for those competitions where grading occurs, the number of dancers that progress to the next grade is based on the number of
- (c) competitors in the competition :-
 - Less than or equal to 20 competitors 1 dancer will progress to the next grade
 - Between 21 - 39 competitors 2 dancers will progress to the next grade
 - Greater than or equal to 40 competitors 3 dancers will progress to the next grade

Bun-Grád:- Confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified for that competition in any other registered competition in any other grade or under any age limit. Dancers must perform basic material

Tus-Grád:- Confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified for that competition in any other registered competition in any other grade or under any age limit other than in Bun Grad. • Dancers must perform their first advanced material. This should **exclude** clicks, twists, swivels, cross keys, rocks etc

Mean-Grád:- Competitions are confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified, for that competition, in any other registered competition, under the upper age-limit specified for the competition (or under a higher age-limit) outside of Bun-grad and Tus-grad. The same level of material can be performed for Mean-Grád and Árd-Grád.

Primary Grád (Munster Specific Criteria):- Competitions are confined to competitors who have never previously grade out of a competition for the dance specified, in any registered competition, in any grade or under any age limit other than in Bun or Tus or Primary grád. Dancers can perform the same level of material acceptable in Mean or Árd Grád competition. Solo costumes can be worn. Once a dancer wins a dance in Primary grade, they are no longer eligible to

Árd Grád:- An Árd-grád competition shall be open to any dancer who satisfies all the following qualifying conditions: is a pupil of a registered teacher, is qualified to compete as regards age and place of residence, is not suspended from competitions under any Rule or by a decision of An Coimisiun or of a Regional Authority and is entered with the permission of his/her teacher.

Where a dancer has won first prize and thereafter fails to win a prize for that particular dance, the teacher of that dancer may, when a period of two years has elapsed, apply to the regional council to have the dancer re-graded as a mean grád dancer.

Preliminary (Pre-Lim) Grád (Munster specific criteria only):- Competitions are confined to competitors who have never previously won an Árd competition for the dance specified, for that competition in any other registered competition, under any age limit. Winners of a Pre-Lim competition are not graded out of the Pre-Lim grade. Only the winning of an Open competition or Championship will affect a dancer's participation in this grade. Dancers can perform the same level of material acceptable in Mean or Árd Grád competition. Solo costumes can be worn by dancers in this grade. A winner of a Pre-lim solo competition automatically eliminates the dancer from dancing that dance in Bun, Tus or Mean.

If a dancer fails to win that Pre-lim dance again in the next two years, they can apply to Comhairle na Mumhan to be re-graded to Mean Grade again. The re-grading is entirely at the discretion of the Munster Regional Council.
