Dear Teachers and Parents,

It is my pleasure to invite you all to Ennis for the seventh 'Feis Magh Adhair', hosted by the Michael Dillon School. Once again we are delighted to be at the West County hotel, which is familiar to most of you from various major Oireachtasi over the years.

Each year we try our very best to produce an accurate timetable, so please help us and ensure that all entries are submitted by the closing date. Only Championships need be pre-entered, but we would appreciate getting a list of the grade entries so we can have numbers prepared at the entry table.

**Remember, if grades are pre-entered (and paid for) , dancers can dance in the grade entered, regardless of grading up at a feis subsequent to that entry being received.**

In 2009 we decided to experiment with 100% recalls across the board. To facilitate this and to keep the timetable running more efficiently we have six adjudicators this year. We will run the same system as the All Irelands and Worlds, where the panel and the competitors will move to hall B for their set dance. If the timetable allows at any point over the weekend, the sets will be danced in Hall A.

Due to the poor entry in our pre-lim championships last year we only have open championships, but all dancers will be placed in every Championship. Dancers in the bottom 50% of the result will be presented with a medal but their place will not be called. Marks will be available after each competition so dancers can see where they placed. The points for the top 50% will be posted in a public area.

There will be sashes or pennants for the top five in every age group.

In the grade competitions there will be trophies for the top five in all the trophy reel competitions and a plaque for first in all grade solos.

**Bun and Tus grad is open to all regions. In Munster wigs are allowed in Bun and Tus.**

**We are introducing Treble reel competitions this year with crystal for the winner in each category.**

We are delighted to be back at the West County who have reduced their rates this year for the feis. To ensure you get a room in the hotel please book as soon as possible as the hotel is usually full for this event.

## **RIALACHA NA FEILE**

1. Entries will only be accepted from teachers currently registered with An Coimisiun le Rinci Gaelacha
2. Any objections, other than those related to adjudicator's decisions, must be lodged **in writing** to the feis Committee. There will be a fee of €15.00 associated with such an objection. If the feis committee cannot resolve the issue satisfactorily, the objection will be forwarded to Comhairle Na Mumhan.
3. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder, commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competition.
4. The adjudicator's decision is final
5. The feis committee will not accept responsibility for personal injuries or articles lost at the feis
6. There is absolutely no smoking permitted anywhere in the hall.
7. The committee as far as is practicable, will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However, the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgment of any entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by a dancer and by his/her parent/guardian.
8. Bun & Tus Mean, and Ard competitions are open to all regions.
9. Dancing is only permitted in the designated areas
10. Cars are parked at owner's risk
11. Age to be taken from 1st January 2010
12. The use of artificial carriage aids is strictly forbidden except in cases of a medical condition where a doctor's certificate may be requested. Any competitor found to be using such aids and refuses to remove same will be subject to disqualification from that particular competition.
13. In Bun and Tus competition, only class costumes and day wear is allowed
14. Committee members only may approach the adjudicators
15. No block, en pointe, stationary or moving is allowed for all ages up to and including the under 12 age group.
16. Makeup will not be permitted for any dancer in the first two grades up to and including the under 12 age group
17. Under no circumstances should dancers walk around the venue in their underwear. Neither should dancers regardless of age, change into or out of costume in the mail hall. At all times dancers must be properly attired.
18. For those competitions where grading occurs, the number of dancers who are regarded is as follows –
  - a. Less than or equal to 20 – 1 dancer moves up
  - b. 21 – 39 – 2 dancers move up
  - c. 40 and over – 3 dancers move up(Please note where more than one dancer moves up all will be awarded the same prize)
19. Treble reel competitions - any style allowed
