Rialacha do Fo-chomórtaisí Oireachtas Rince na Mumhan 2010

1. Age to be taken as at the 1st January 2010.
 2. Entries accepted only from teachers registered with An Coimisiún Le Rince Gaelacha.
 3. Adjudicator's decision is final.
 4. Objections in writing accepted from registered teachers only within one hour of the completion of the competition with a fee of €20.00.
 5. Any form of unauthorized photography which has the capability to capture a dancer's image whilst in motion, using electronic or manual means e.g. mobile phone, standard camera, video camcorder, cine recorder commercial film, with or without flash enhancement, is expressly forbidden in competitions.
 6. At all times dancers must be properly attired. Dancers (if possible) should not change costume in the main dancing hall.
 7. Comhairle na Mumhan will not accept responsibility for personal injury or articles lost at the Feile.
 8. Comhairle na Mumhan will as far as practicable provide stage surfaces suitable for Irish Dancing. However, the Feile Committee cannot accept liability whatsoever for any injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgment of an entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of this provision by the dancer, parent or guardian.
 9. All Grad Competitions are open to all regions
 10. **Bun Grad;** Every Bun-grad competition shall be confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified, for that competition, in any other registered competition or under any age limit. Dancers must perform basic material only.
 11. **Tus Grad;** Every Tus-grad competition shall be confined to competitors who have never previously won first place, for the dance specified, for that competition, in any other registered competition or under any age limit, other than in Bun Grad.
 12. **Primary Grád: (Munster specific criteria)** Primary competition is confined to competitors who have never previously graded out of a competition for the dance specified, in any other registered competition, in any other grade or under any age limit other than in Bun or Tus or Primary Grade.
 - Dancers can perform the same level of material acceptable in Mean or Árd Grád competition.
 - Solo costumes can be worn by dancers in this grade.
 - Once a dancer wins a dance in Primary grade, they are no longer eligible to enter that dance in that grade again.
- Mean Grad;** Every Mean-grad competition shall be confined to competitors who have never previously won first place for the dance specified, for that competition, in any other registered competition, under the upper age-limit specified for the competition (or under a higher age-limit) outside of Bun-grad and Tus-grad. Dancers must perform their first advanced material. The same level of material can be performed for Mean-Grad and Ard-Grad competitions

Preliminary (Pre-Lim) Grad (Munster specific criterial only)

Every Preliminary competition must be confined to competitors who have never previously won an Ard competition for the dance specified for that competition in any other registered competition under any age limit other than the Pre-Lim grade. Winners of a Pre-Lim competition are not graded out of the Pre-Lim grade. Only the winning of an Open competition or Championship will affect a dancer's participation in this grade.

- Dancers can perform the same level of material acceptable in Mean or Ard Ghrad competition.
Solo costumes can be worn by dancers in this grade.
 - A winner of a Pre-lim solo competition automatically eliminates the dancer from dancing that dance in Bun, Tus or Mean.
 - If a dancer fails to win that Pre-lim dance again in the next two years, they can apply to Comhairle na Mumhan to be re-graded to Mean Grade again. The re-grading is entirely at the discretion of the Munster Regional Council.
13. No blocks, *en pointe*, stationary or moving are allowed for all ages up to and including under 12 age group with the exception of the 11-12 age group who may perform this working as and from the 1st September 2009.
14. **Effective from the 1st January 2009** for those competitions where grading occurs, the number of dancers that progress to the next grade is based on the number of competitors in the competition:-
- Less than or equal to 20 competitors: 1 dancer will progress to next grade
 - Between 21 – 39 competitors: 2 dancers will progress to next grade
 - Greater than or equal to 40 competitors: 3 dancers will progress to next grade
15. A competition in which there are five competitors or less shall not count for grading purposes i.e. the winner of such a competition shall be entitled to and grade.
16. Costume rule: All girl competitors in all Bun, Tus Grad and under 5 competitions must wear either their class costume or day dress and all boys must wear their class costume or shirt and pants.
17. The use of make-up is not permitted in Bun and Tus Grad competitions up to and including the under 12 age group
18. The use of artificial carriage aids is strictly forbidden. Medically prescribed apparatus, proof of which may be required, (Doctors Certificate) will be exempt from this ruling.
